The crested caracara is called 'Warawara' in Papiamentu. The Warawara is a bird of prey that is increasingly common in Aruba. The Warawara is a scavenger that occasionally also eats lizards, mice, and goat carcasses among others. It produces a rattling screaming sound, often throwing its head back. The Warawara has a wingspan of 120 cm wide, and is brown-black in color. There is no difference in appearance between the male and female Warawara. A fun fact about the Warawara is that it would rather walk than fly.
