

CBA launches digital survey on food security

Food security is defined as a situation that exists when all people, at all times, have physical, social and economic access to sufficient, safe and nutritious food that meets their dietary needs and food preferences for an active and healthy life.

Food security is important, as it can lead to better health, the empowerment of women, greater economic stability, and a reduction in climate problems.

In order to gain a better understanding on the state of food security in Aruba, the Centrale Bank van Aruba (CBA) will conduct a digital survey on food security from August 16, 2024 through September 16, 2024.

The survey aims to measure how food security is experienced in Aruba. The data obtained will provide the CBA with insights into the state of food security in Aruba, and enable the CBA to draft policy recommendations related to the topic.

The CBA emphasizes that the survey is strictly anonymous and guarantees that all information received will be treated confidentially and used only for statistical purposes and policy.
